A Special Congregational Meeting will be held for the purpose of a discussion and vote to add the following clause to the By-Laws of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Saco and Biddeford. "In keeping with the tradition of Unitarian Universalism, the Minister has freedom of the pulpit and freedom of political and religious expression in representing her or his own views and in taking action on her or his own behalf. The Minister does not speak for the congregation, however, without being specifically empowered by the congregation to do so." This addition to the by-laws is recommended by the Ministerial Search Committee, Interim Minister Steve Cook, and the Board of Trustees, and as such is considered very important as we move forward with the ministerial search. A quorum of eligible voting members will be required for this vote so please plan to attend.
