# Share the Plate for June: LGBTQ+ Collection, USM Library

The Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer+ Collection at the University of Southern Maine collects and preserves the history of Maine's LGBTQ+ communities. We collect the papers of individuals and the records of organizations active in these communities. The collection includes all forms of material culture from printed books, pamphlets, posters, to manuscripts, diaries, to objects, buttons, T-shirts, banners, games, a wide variety of ephemera, to photographs and audiovisual material. Following professional standards, we carefully guard the privacy of individuals involved in the collections. The LGBTQ+ Collection is arguably the most significant and comprehensive collection of primary materials documenting the history and culture of Maine's 20-21st century lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer communities. Its Collection Advisory Committee actively seeks new collections and creates programming that educates and empowers Maine.
