Hello Good People,

On this Palm Sunday we will explore the long and winding roads. The fourth month, the fourth stage of our 6-month pilgrimage. It is the Contemplation stage: Some pilgrimages go the direct route to the Holy, right to the center of the Holy of Holies, directly to the heart of the matter. Others take a more indirect route, circling around the outside of the sacred place, transforming the physical journey into a spiritual path of contemplation. A long and winding road, if you will. In the Christian tradition, Palm Sunday marks the start of Holy Week. A somber, pensive march towards death of Jesus. For this week's lectio divina, I invite you to experience this clip from the musical Gospel to prepare you to explore the stage of our journey. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=fX6dq7cNIOA

Watch and listen to this clip 2-3 times. As you listen, drop into your heart space and do some deep breathing. Feel the vibrations of the harmony and the music wash over you. Often times glimpses of the Holy happen when the veil is pulled away during hard times. We will explore this idea through reflection on Palm Sunday, and

in other parts of our lives and society. Questions to consider; what does this song bring up for me? What long and winding path am I on right now? This is the contemplation part of our journey. Who is there with you? How do you accompany them even when the path is a difficult one? Who is in our world that needs our accompaniment? How are we journeying with them, even when we can "fix" it?
