Thoughts from Rev. Lori ٠

On Belonging

I just read an article by Naomi Hathaway about belonging and its psychological and neurological effects. Many of us have heard that belonging produces happiness which reduces stress and is effective in deterring depression. Physiologically, feelings of isolation cause neurological reactions that we experience when we have a physical injury. Wounding is wounding, whether emotionally or physically. Belonging is this month's theme and so I am asking you to consider something. Hathaway says that "seeing others become vulnerable and become encouraged by other people is actually watching belonging be constructed." Belonging lies in our vulnerability not our strength and competence. It makes me think about our Sunday Service and how important the Sharing from the Heart is. For people to hear what challenges and joys are and being able to lift them up collectively is indeed creating belonging. I invite you consider where you are vulnerable. How can you open yourselves up in community in an authentic way? How can you support others in doing so? I leave you with two words. Belonging and vulnerability.

READ this passage, close your eyes and picture these words in your mind's eye. MEDITATE what sentences or words resonate for you? PRAY Ask what is being communicated to you through this passage and where it shows up in your life?
