Here we are in mid summer. Although it feels like the very beginning as we are getting more sun for these last two weeks than we did the first half of summer, We are knocking on August's door. I have pledged to my family that I would slow down this summer. Take more pauses than I am used to. Stick my toes in the sand as often as possible.
