## Thoughts from Rev. Lori

Hello Good People,

This has felt like a strange summer to me. Hot/rainy/cool. I love August for its warm days and cool nights, changing light and most of all the sound of the cicadas. I share this poem with you from the 2nd or 3rd century written by a Hellenistic poet:

We bless you, cicada high in the branches You sip a dew drop and whistle like a king What you see is yours; all soft the meadows and furry mountains. Yet vou do no harm in the farmer's field. and men exalt you as the voice of summer. You are loved by Muses and Apollo himself who gave a clear song. Wise child of the earth, old age doesn't waste you. Unfeeling and bloodless you are like a god.

The cicada is voice of summer, but cicadas do no harm. They are a siren call to the sweet peace/piece of summer. Let these short last weeks of summer be a time of incubation and discernment about how and what we want our voices to communicate to each other, the community and the world.

Read the poem out loud
Meditate and notice what word sticks with you
Pray about what that word is saying to you
Contemplate-bring the word forward with you through the days ahead
