Hello Good People

It was not too long ago. Less than a year and a half that we gathered behind our church with members of other faith communities to mark and lament the terrible tragedy at the Uvalde school. I believe many of us were deeply impacted by the senselessness of it and the great loss of innocents. And still somehow it felt far away. At least for me. I also realized as time crept by that lessons were not learned. Changes were not made. Thoughts and prayers may have been plentiful by policy and action was not addressed. Now we sit and stand and gather heartbroken! Personally affected by what has taken place. The first thing that hit me when I sat to prepare us for Sunday was ...what is there left to say? It has been said and said and said. Without words the first thing is to tend to our own grief and grieving. To make space for all the grief that this has stirred up in ourselves. The memories of other tragedies from years past that have made a mark. The next is to reflect on what sources of strength we have leaned on in our past and figure out how can we lean on them again right now? • Annual Meeting Part II – October 29

The Board of Trustees has voted to resume the Annual Meeting to address the remaining issue that was tabled: the approval of funds to replace the aging oil burner.

The motion as presented is:

Motion to Approve: Allow the Board of Trustees to use up to \$37,000 from a combination of existing savings and the endowment fund, which is \$ 159,281 as of the beginning of June, to replace the current oil burner system with a newer, more highly efficient oil burner system.

CENTER FOR WABANAKI RESEARCH, KNOWLEDGE & INNOVATION: The mission of the Center for Wabanaki Research, Knowledge & Innovation is to create a world where Wabanaki people overcome barriers to improve health and wellness in our communities empowered by Wabanaki-led data and research.
