Thoughts from Rev. Lori

Hello Good People,

What do we hold on to? The theme for November is generosity so it would seem that I would be talking about what we give away. In order to cultivate generosity, it can be helpful to consider what we hold on to. Because what we hold on to holds onto us. Faith tells us there is enough for everyone. If we share, if we give there is enough. Parker Palmer says in "Let Your Life Speak,

In the human world, abundance does not happen automatically. It is created when we have the sense to choose community, to come together to celebrate and share our *common store*. Whether the scarce resource is money or love or power... the true law of life is that we generate more of whatever seems scarce by trusting its supply and passing it around. Authentic abundance is not found in secured stockpiles of food or cash or influence or affection but in belonging to a community where we can give those goods to others who need them — and receive them from others when we are in need.... Community doesn't just create abundance - community is abundance. If we could learn that equation from the world of nature, the human world might be transformed.

MEDITATE let your mind rest on a word or phrase from the passage

REFLECT ask yourself what that word or phrase means to you in your life take realizations with you into the weekend and to our time together
