We are beginning to develop a plan to replace the supports under the main entrance. The beams have been deteriorating for many years due to an error in constructing the platform outside the main doors. We are waiting for a written report from the structural engineers which will outline the problem and suggest resolutions. During the service Jane Perkins will explain this issue further. At present two members recognized the need to start a fund for this work. They donated \$500 to kick off this fund. (Our last estimate, done several years ago, was \$46,000). This month half the plate will be kept at the UUCSB for this work.
