A Sunday slow, the pews left bare, No hymns to rise, no whispered prayer. The halls are silent, doors stay closed, One week to wander, mind composed.

Light filters in through windows still, No organ calls, no hands to greet. Yet faith persists, not bound by walls— It breathes in rest, and softly calls. Hello friends,

I write this while en route to some time away...my week to wander. I realized that our halls are never really silent. Brian bustles around doing all the things that keep us knit together. B&G is also always around caring for our beautiful building and preparing for every next thing! Yet, you are all on your bi-week as they say in the sports world. A rest week. A reset week. I hope this time prepares us all for what is to come next Sunday!

I invite you to close your eyes and take a deep breath. While we won't be in our building let's come to church in our minds.
